

# **Standart-type apartments**JUNE

## Standard-Type Apartments, July 1, 2021

In June 2021, the prices of standard-type apartments in Riga's housing estates increased - they increased by 2 % during the month. The average price of standard-type apartments rose to 851 EUR /  $m^2$ . In 2021, the prices of standard-type apartments have increased by 5.4 %.



In all major housing estates of Riga, in June 2021, an increase in the prices of standard-type apartments was observed. Price increases were the highest both this year and in recent years. The supply of apartments was small in all housing estates of Riga, thus prices tended to increase. Apartment prices also increased in the vicinity of Riga, where they grew even faster than in Riga. In the first half of the year, apartment prices in the vicinity of Riga increased by 9-13 %.

Since 2021, the number of apartments offered for sale in the largest housing estates has dropped below 1,000. This level of supply is most common at the end of the year, when the real estate market becomes less active. In June, the number of offers was even lower - it was just over 900 offers.

#### Dynamics of apartment supply in the largest housing estates of Riga



Since the beginning of 2021, in all major housing estates of Riga prices of apartments have generally increased. The largest price increase since the beginning of the year has been observed in Imanta (+7,1 %).




#### Price changes in the largest housing estates of Riga since January 1, 2021, %

In June 2021, the average price of standard-type apartments increased to 851 EUR/m². The prices on average were by 47 % lower than on July 1, 2007, when the average price of a non-renovated standard-type apartment reached the highest ever value.

In June, changes in apartment prices were observed. The average price per square meter of standard-type apartments increased for one-room (+2.4 %), two-room (+1.6 %), three-room (+1.8 %) and four-room (+2 %) apartments.





In June, the supply of apartments in Riga decreased by 7 % compared to the previous month. The number of apartments offered for sale in the largest housing estates of Riga analysed by "ARCO REAL ESTATE" decreased by 5 %. Compared to June 2020, the supply of apartments was generally lower: the total number of apartments offered for sale was 18 % lower than a year ago, but the supply of apartments in the largest housing estates was 30 % lower than a year ago.


#### Dynamics of supply of apartments in Riga

Having summarized the number of apartments offered for sale in the housing estates of Riga, it can be concluded that the largest supply of apartments in June was in Purvciems, while the lowest - in Bolderāja.

#### Number of apartments offered for sale in Riga at the end of June 2021





Last month, the supply of apartments in the largest housing estates of Riga mostly decreased. The supply decreased the most in Iļģuciems – by 32 %, while it increased the most in Imanta (+28 %).

When analysing the supply of apartments in proportion to the size of the housing estate, i. e., by population, the largest supply in June was found in Mežciems, while in Bolderāja the supply was proportionally the lowest.

In June, changes in the prices of standard-type apartments in the largest housing estates of Riga were observed. Apartment prices increased in all major housing estates. The largest price increase was observed in Teika and Iļģuciems, where prices increased by 2.4 % during the month. The smallest changes affected Pļavnieki, where prices increased by 1.4 %.



Compared to the beginning of 2020, in June the prices of standard-type apartments were higher by 4 %. But since the beginning of 2021, prices have increased by 5 %.

#### Average standard-type apartment prices in housing estates of Riga, EUR/m<sup>2</sup>



The highest prices of standard-type apartments in June remained in Teika, where the price per square meter increased to 995 EUR/m². The lowest average price per square meter in June was in Bolderāja – 622 EUR/m², which also increased during the month.


#### Average standard-type apartment prices in housing estates of Riga as per July 1, 2021, EUR/m<sup>2</sup>

In June, the most expensive apartments still were apartments in the houses of the series 119 and 104, where the price of 2-room apartments in a satisfactory condition varied from 51 000 to 56 000 EUR depending on the location. In turn, the so-called Lithuanian design were the cheapest ones, where the price of 2-room apartments varied from 29 000 to 42 000 EUR, and the so-called Khrushchev-time houses, where the price of 2-room apartments varied from 28 000 to 42 000 EUR depending on the housing estate.

## Apartment market in the vicinity of Riga

#### Ogre

In June, the prices of standard-type apartments in Ogre increased by 2 %, reaching an average apartment price of 729 EUR/m<sup>2</sup>. In the first half of 2021, apartment prices in Ogre increased by 11 %.


#### Kauguri, Jūrmala

In Kauguri, the prices of standard-type apartments increased by 4 % in June. The average price of one square meter of apartments rose to 702 EUR/m². Since the beginning of 2021, apartment prices in Kauguri have increased by 12 %.

#### Salaspils

In June, apartment prices in Salaspils increased by 3 %. The average price per square meter of standard-type apartments in Salaspils increased to 761 EUR/m². This year, the prices of standard-type apartments in Salaspils have increased by 9 %.

#### Jelgava

Last month, apartment prices in Jelgava increased by 4 %, but the average price of standard-type apartments reached 611 EUR/m<sup>2</sup>. In the first half of 2021, the prices of standard-type apartments in Jelgava increased by 13 %.
